

This is unbelievable, Debra, I want you to read this email with the understanding that I sympathise with your situation and want to help further your understanding, however, this whole site is full of propaganda and poorly researched scare tactics, and it really worries me that you consider yourself an authority on anything cannabis related. I speak as a parent of 3, 2 of which smoke cannabis regularly, one is an orthodontist and the other is an established civil lawyer.
